



How to measure your paving area

Step one is knowing the exact dimensions of the area you want to pave. Using a tape measure and string measure out your area. We recommend doing this multiple times to ensure you have an accurate measurement. Once you have measured your area, you can start to draw up your plan.

The quantity of the materials needed for the paving job depends upon the total area to be paved. This can be determined from measurements taken off the plan or if the area to be paved has been pegged out on site. The area is simply calculated by measuring the width and length of the area to be paved.

length (m) x width (m) = area (m²

FOR RECTANGULAR AREAS


base (m) x height (m) = AREA (m²)



eg. 3m x 5m = 15m²

FOR TRIANGULAR AREAS


0.5 x base (m) x height (m) = AREA (m²)



eg. $0.5 \times 3m \times 5m = 7.5m^2$

FOR ODD-SHAPED AREAS

Area 1 m² + Area 2 m² + Area 3 m² = TOTAL AREA (m²)



Midland Brick recommend calculating the square metre area to be covered and adding 5% to allow for cuts and wastage. To calculate this:

Area to be paved (m^2) x 1.05 (allows for 5% cutting) = (m^2) total m^2 of pavers required Based on your estimate, Midland Brick will advise the number of packs or pallets required.

Installation & Specification Guide

Some Useful Terms

Paver

A small format, solid paving unit having a gross plan area less than, or equal to 0.05m^2 used in combination with bedding sand to form a surfacing layer,

Large format paver

A solid paving unit, with a gross plan area greater than or equal to 0.05m^2 which should be considered a flag in paving applications relating to control joints and edge restraints,

Flag

A large format solid paving unit, each with a gross plan area exceeding 0.08m² used in combination with bedding sand to form a surfacing layer.

Sub-base

An optional layer of soil placed between the excavated subgrade and the basecourse material.

Subgrade

The ground on which the pavement is to be placed.

Basecourse

The layer of material placed on either the subgrade or sub-base to support the surface course.

Surface

The layer that includes the pavers and a course of bedding material.

Edge Restraint

A row of pavers or other material that provides an edge to the pavement, and ensures that the pavers do not move.

Joints

The gaps between pavers, which are usually filled with sand or grout to prevent displacement.

How to Lay Pavers

1. Prepare the site

To determine your finished paving level, consider the following:

- finished paving must be below the damp proof course level of any building.
- · paving must slope away from buildings.
- allow for the depth of the base layer, bedding sand and paver.

Excavate the area and ensure the ground is level.

2. Base layer

For vehicular areas a base course is recommended for increased strength beneath your segmental paving. The base course should be formed from a well-graded granular material such as gravel or crushed rock and be compacted between layers. Further details on specifications can be found in AS3727.1.

3. Bedding layer

The bedding layer should be uniformly spread across the compacted base layer, the bedding layer should be from course, well-graded washed sand, free from organic materials.

4. Laving the pavers

Setting Out. To ensure the integrity of your pattern, use string grid lines spaced at exact intervals around the perimeter of the job.

Cutting. Ensure product is fully wetted (soaked with water) to reduce any cutting slurry staining the product. Similarly, wash any slurry from product before laying and ensure slurry does not fall onto laid areas. Pavers should not be cut to less than 25% of their original size.

Laying pattern. It is recommended to lay pavers for a driveway in an interlocking pattern such as herringbone with either a 45 or 90-degree configuration. This is the strongest pattern, and it will minimise the movement of individual paving units due to traffic. For large square format pavers and flags, consider the implication of not achieving interlock and whether these products are best suited for your application.

Blending. To achieve even blending, select and blend randomly from different packs or pallets as you lay.

5. Edge restraints.

Edge Restraints prevent pavers from moving horizontally and also contain the sand and road base. Edge restraints should be provided around the periphery of concrete flag pavements to the full depth of the paver or flag. Edge restraints may comprise of exposed or concealed concrete beam, barriers constructed using pre-mixed concrete or appropriate kerbing options. These minimise the loss of base courses and the sideways movements of pavers and flags. Edge restraints must be capable of accepting the specified vehicle loads.

6. Control Joints

Where unrestrained edging is used and pavers are laid correctly (with gaps between), control joints are generally not required. However, in large areas restrained by walls, kerbing or long driveways, or when using large format paving or flags, it may be necessary to include control joints. A control joint is a 10-15mm gap between sections of the paved area. Spacing of the joints will vary depending on the pattern design and should be positioned at points of stress, like re-entrant corners and at points not exceeding 6 metres. Control joints can be filled with compressible material such as Abel Flex. Usually paving expansion occurs with change in temperature. Darker colours tend to move more, and the paving will always give way at the weakest point – usually the edge restraint.

7. Joint filling & Compacting

Sweep dry, fine whitewashed sand over the paving ensuring that all the joints are full. Compact the pavers using a mechanical plate compactor with a piece of clean carpet under the plate to prevent scratching or damage. After the first compaction, sweep in more jointing sand and compact again before sweeping off excess sand.

8. Sealing of pavers

To ensure optimum appearance and reduced maintenance, Midland Brick recommends sealing masonry pavers as soon as laid and when completely dry. Please consult a sealer manufacturer or contractor for more advice. The sealer will help slow down the absorption of any spill but remember to quickly wash down any spills immediately. WARNING: Hydrochloric acid should NOT be used with any masonry pavers as irreparable surface damage may occur.

Important Information

All prices shown will be charged at the ruling rate on date of delivery. Delivery charges are not included.

Safety Information. We have safety information sheets available providing details on brick cutting, cleaning, safe storage and movement of bricks and payers.

Ordering Product. When ordering product, we recommend they are all delivered at the same time to ensure colour consistency, as colours will vary within and between batches.

Product Inspection. We strongly recommend at all times there be careful inspections and supervision of all pavers delivered to ensure satisfactory results prior to and during installation. Any complaints regarding product should be directed to the place of purchase PRIOR to laying.

Sizing. Product supplied is within the dimensional tolerances specified in Australia/New Zealand Standard AS/NZS 4455. For further information please contact Midland Brick. Sizes and number per square metre are nominal only and subject to variance due to installation technique, product colour and size variation through manufacturing processes.

Colour Blending. For the best colour blending results, blend your pavers from various packs as you lay.

Paver Face. Some pavers have subtle variation in colour and texture where either face can be used. The choice is yours.

Colour Variation. Products on display are examples. Variation will occur naturally within a production run and with each production run of products.

Bullnose Pavers. Due to the machining process all requirements for each project must be ordered at once to ensure colour, texture and profile consistency.

Chipping and Breakage. Some minor chipping and breakage can occur during the delivery, offloading and installation of products. It is recommended that this product be used for cuts and infills.

Cutting. When cutting products, please ensure that the product is fully wetted (soaked with water), to reduce the chance of discolouration from cutting slurry entering the product surface. Similarly, ensure all slurry is washed from any cut product before laying. Ensure that no cutting slurry falls on surface of product already laid.

Cleaning. Ensure that no acid based products are used to clean surfaces of masonry products.

Paving Installation. In accordance with accepted engineering principles, Midland Brick recommends allowing 2-3mm joints between clay pavers for clean jointing sand to be swept in between pavers to ensure effective lock up and the use of a base course layer under all segmental pavements subjected to vehicular traffic. Masonry Pavers already contain 2mm nibs on each edge.

Control Joints. Control joints are generally not required when pavers are laid over unbound bedding sand and appropriate gaps are incorporated between adjacent pavers. However, in large areas of flexible paving restrained by walls, kerbing, etc. or long driveways it may be necessary to include control joints. A control joint consists of a 10-15mm gap between the sections of the pavers. Spacing of the control joints will vary depending on the design and should be positioned to coincide with points of weakness, re-entrant corners and centres not exceeding 6 metres. Control joints can be filled using a compressible material such as Abel Flex. Usually expansion of the paving mass occurs due to the change in ambient temperature. Darker coloured pavers tend to move more and the paving will always give way at the weakest point, which is usually the edge restraint.

Crossovers and Driveways.

In accordance with accepted engineering principles Midland Brick recommends the use of a sub-base course layer under all clay segmental brick pavements subjected to vehicular traffic as referred to in Midland Brick's Crossover and Driveway document. When paving crossovers you should first contact your local shire to ensure you comply with their specifications.

Bedding Sand. Bedding material should be a well graded clean sand. A well graded concreting or plasterer's sand is considered suitable. Salt attack is a potential problem with some clay and masonry paving and the capillary break provided by the bedding sand is essential. Fatty sands, loams or packing sands are not suitable.

Joint Filling Sand. Should be clean, sharp, well graded and finer than bedding sand with no soluble salts and no excessive fine material. A washed dry white sand is recommended.

Abrasive Objects. Minor edge chipping can occur when steel drum rollers, mowers or edgers pass over paving bricks. When moving the above machinery across pavers, insertion of a rubber strip or carpet between paver and machine will alleviate this chipping.

Tyre Markings. Tyre markings may appear on any type of pavement surface due to tyre compounds, vehicle weight, direction and the action of power steering.

Salt Water Pools. Paving should be protected from salt water with a suitable sealer to a minimum width of 2m from the pool edge. Ask your Midland Brick Sales Advisor for more information about our range of sealers today. Sealers should be renewed periodically as recommended by the sealer manufacturer. When clay or masonry product is subjected to severe salt attack situations, some deterioration may occur over time. For Bullnose pavers we recommend sealing both sides of the paver prior to installation.

Colour Fastness. All concrete pavers will fade over time when exposed to direct sunlight. To maintain and enhance the chosen colour, sealing the pavers is recommended.

Sealing. To protect the life of your finished project and to allow easy cleaning, Midland Brick recommends that your paving be sealed - in particular, paving in coastal areas or harsh environments. The application of a sealer will protect your investment and maintain the paver's appearance. Refer to page 23.

Efflorescence. A white powdery deposit known as efflorescence may sometimes appear on any concrete or masonry product. Efflorescence appears due to the migration of salts via evaporation to the surfaces of the paver. This is a temporary effect as the pavers acclimatise to their new environment.

Country Orders. Bricks and pavers can be double strapped, packed and strapped onto pallets and/or shrink wrapped for country cartage on request. 48 hours notice required. Price on application. Note: Clients are reminded that when picking up product ex works, vehicles must have side gates or mesh. Mesh can be purchased direct from Midland Brick.

Loose Loading. Load restraint laws restrict what and how we load loose product into vehicles. Loose products can only be loaded into vehicles with an enclosed boot or with a cargo barrier in place. A service fee applies for all products loaded loose. Please check with a Sales Advisor for further details.

Trailer Weight Restrictions. Due to weight restrictions your garden trailer may not be suitable. If your trailer is not marked with load specifications, you can only load a maximum of half a pack of pavers/face bricks. Suitable trailers are available for hire from Midland Brick.







