Soil Mixes	Landscape Mix	Composted organics, sand and peat. Complies to Australian Standard 4419 for Landscape soils.	Suitable for the quick establishment of lawn and garden beds for most plant types; For either small or large areas.
	Lawn Mix	Topdressing sand, gingin loam and poultry manure.	Excellent topdressing for stimulating tired lawns and leveling uneven lawns. Spread at 10mm (max). Apply spring to late summer for best results. DO NOT APPLY DURING HIGH SUMMER TEMPERATURES AS IT COULD CAUSE BURNING. IMMEDIATELY WATER IN AFTER APPLICATION.
	Native Mix	Gingin loam, peat, sand and composted organics. Complies to Australian Standard 4419 for Landscape soils.	A low phosphorus soil for Australian natives. An excellent mix with sufficient water retention properties to provide a good base for native plants.
	Organic Vegie Mix	Poultry manure, composted organics, peat, quartz sand & Gingin loam.	A rich organic mix – ideal for either a new or established vegie patch. It is recommended to grow seeds or young seedlings in a seed & cutting mix prior to planting into this rich organic mix. NOT TO BE USED FOR NATIVE PLANTS.
	Potting Mix	Medium grade pinebark, gingin quartz, sawdust, NPK and minor trace elements.	Regular Grade Potting Mix – requires the addition of a controlled release fertiliser.
Soil Conditioners	Fine Compost	Composted organics and recycled greenwaste. Complies to Australian Standard 4454 for composts, mulches and soil conditioners.	A peat-free composted soil conditioner that is high in organic matter, nutrients and trace elements. Spread at 50mm and dig in to depth of 100mm.
	Metro Soil Conditioner	Peat, composted organics and recycled greenwaste. Complies to Australian Standard 4454 for composts, mulches and soil conditioners.	A black, rich organic composted soil conditioner which provides adequate plant nutrients and trace elements, and stimulates microbial activity. It has excellent water retention capacity. Spread at 50mm and dig in to depth of 100mm.
	Lawn Marvel	Composted organics, sawdust and poultry manure. Complies to Australian Standard 4454 for composts, mulches and soil conditioners.	A specialised blend of organic ingredients which will give turf a rich green look and encourage a healthy root system, as well as moisture and nutrient retention in the soil profile. Spread at 5mm max., brush in over area and WATER IN WELL IMMEDIATELY AFTER APPLICATION. DO NOT APPLY DURING HIGH SUMMER TEMPERATURES AS IT COULD CAUSE BURNING.

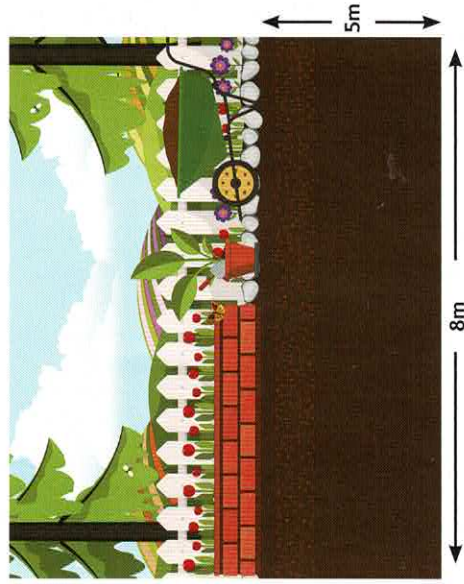
How Much Will I Need?

How much will I need? Simple! To calculate how much soil conditioner or mulch you will need, just multiply...

$$\text{LENGTH} \times \text{WIDTH} \times \text{DEPTH} = \text{TOTAL REQUIRED}$$

$$8\text{m} \times 5\text{m} \times 0.05\text{m} (50\text{mm}) = 2\text{m}^3$$

General Information

WHAT IS MULCH?

Mulch is a layer of material covering the soil, providing the principle benefits of:

- Reducing evaporation of water from the soil
- An insulation layer regulating soil temperature
- Helping to control weeds
- Reducing erosion
- Adding nutrients as it breaks down
- Plant pathogens suppression



DIRECTION FOR USE

When mulching try to achieve an even thickness of 75mm (3") over the entire bed but leave a clearance of approximately 25mm (1") around stalks and stems of plants to avoid collar rot – slightly more for larger plants and trees. Occasionally rake the surface of the mulch and annually top up your mulch back to the 75mm (3") thickness.

WHAT IS SOIL CONDITIONER?

Soil conditioner is an organic material which is added to / dug into the soil, providing the principle benefits of:

- Improving soil fertility
- Improving soil structure
- Improving water-holding capacity
- Improving soil-buffer capacity
- Plant pathogens suppression

DIRECTION FOR USE

Apply soil conditioner at the rate of 50mm to existing soil and dig into a depth of 100mm to existing topsoil. Ensure that the coverage is even and that the soil conditioner is not heaped in places. Water in well after application.

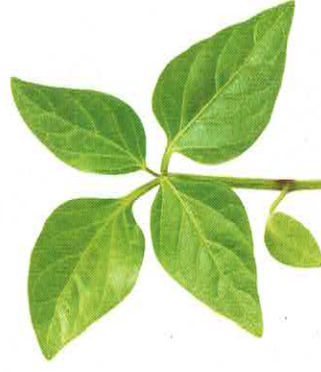
